#### Market Commentary

Global fixed income markets moderately rose in July. On the monetary policy front, the US Federal Reserve hiked its interest rates by a quarter percentage point as they continue to bring inflation back to target. Similarly, the European Central Bank also raised its interest rates by 25 basis points, amid the continued downtrend of inflation in July. The US Treasury yield curve marginally steepened as the 2 year declined by 2 basis points while the 10 and 30-year yields rose by 12 and 15 basis points for the month, amid the Federal Reserve's continued hawkish rhetoric. Riskier fixed income assets outperformed comparable government bonds as market sentiment improved on the back of resilient economic data. Corporate credit spreads tightened across sectors as spreads of US investment-grade, US high-yield and emerging-market fixed income securities declined by 10, 24 and 18 basis points, respectively.

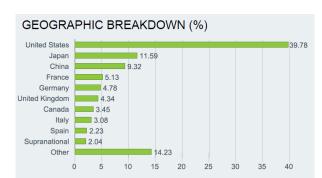
