Market Commentary

Global fixed income markets rallied in November. The US Federal Reserve kept rates unchanged in November. Officials reflected a less hawkish tone while agreeing to proceed carefully on future monetary policy. Officials also remained data dependent as current inflation remained above target despite recent moderation and further evidence will be required for the FOMC to be confident that inflation is on the path back to target. While Federal Reserve Chair Jerome Powell cautioned against premature speculation of rate cuts, markets priced in aggressive rate cut expectations in 2024 amid declining year-ontrend and resilient economy. October year CPI posted lower than expected and lower than September's annual figure.

US 2-year, 10-year and 30-year Treasury Yields declined by 41, 61 and 60 basis points, ending the month at 4.68%, 4.33% and 4.50%, respectively. Riskier fixed income assets outperformed government bonds amid the shift in investor sentiment. Credit spreads tightened across sectors with spreads of global investment grade, global high yield and emerging-market fixed income declining by 21, 59 and 29 basis points, respectively.


